Pattaya, Thailand is an infamous destination for sex tourism and it is the center of child trafficking in Southeast Asia. It is very common for orphans and street children to be sold into sexual slavery or forced into the drug trade. Without Christian love and intervention, many of these children will have their lives ruined by those who would enslave them for their own profit.

Blessing home is a ministry of the Thailand Methodist Mission that provides protection and hope to vulnerable children in Pattaya.

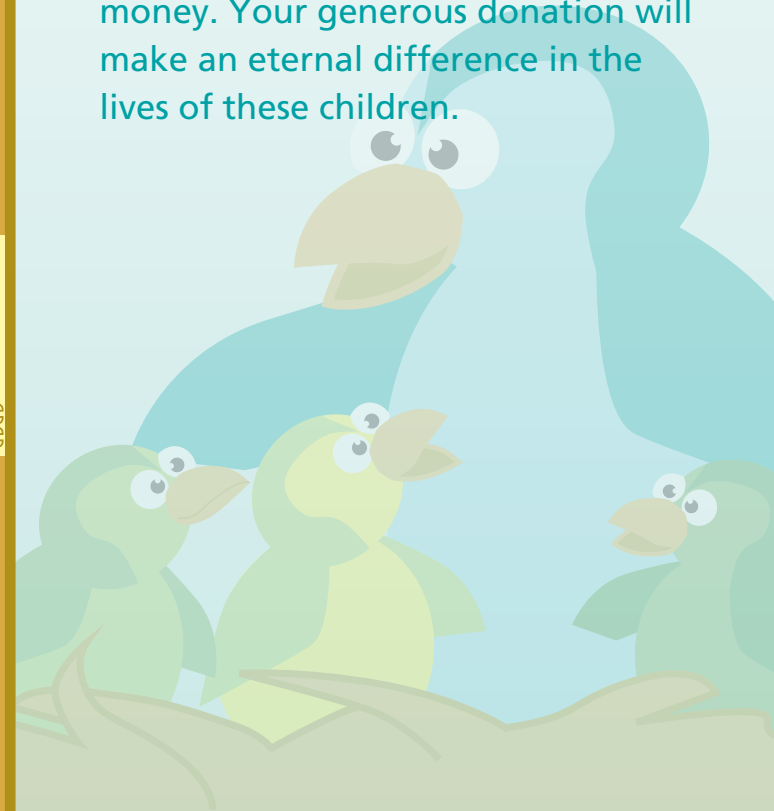
Each child receives Christian nurture and witness, nutritious food, education, medical care, and community social services so that these children can have hope and love.
